Stream A

If you are an assessor who has submitted a Tenancy Lighting Assessmentⁱ in the last 3 years, you are required to complete a re-accreditation application form on the CBD website and pay the 3-year accreditation fee.

Stream B

If you are an assessor who has not submitted a Tenancy Lighting Assessmentⁱ in the last 3 years, you will need to fulfil all requirements under 'Stream A' and also complete the CBD Online Learning Moduleⁱⁱ and pass the CBD TLA Training Examii within 3 months of accreditation.
